At the appropriate place in subtitle A of title XVIII of division A, insert the following:

1 **SEC. 18__.** **REPORT ON CHINA BENEFITTING FROM**
2 **UNITED STATES TAXPAYER-FUNDED RE-**
3 **SEARCH.**

4 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Not later than 1 year after the
5 date of enactment of this Act, the Attorney General, in
6 consultation with the Secretary of the Treasury, the Sec-
7 retary of Commerce, the Secretary of State, and the Direc-
8 tor of National Intelligence, shall submit to the Committee
9 on the Judiciary of the House of Representatives and the
10 Committee on the Judiciary of the Senate a report on the
11 extent to which China has benefitted from United States
12 taxpayer-funded research.

13 (b) **CONTENTS OF REPORT.**—The report under sub-
14 section (a) shall include the following:

15 (1) The extent to which United States tax-
16 payer-funded research has benefitted China, includ-
17 ing a list of entities funded by the United States
18 Government or a State government, such as research

1 institutions, laboratories, and institutions of higher
2 education, which have hired Chinese nationals or al-
3 lowed Chinese nationals to conduct research, includ-
4 ing an estimate of the number of nationals hired or
5 involved in research projects.

6 (2) A list of United States Government pro-
7 grams, grants, and other forms of research funding
8 in the fields of science, technology, engineering, and
9 math fields that have directly or indirectly cooper-
10 ated or affiliated with research institutions in China
11 or Chinese Communist Party entities.

12 (3) The extent to which China’s funding of
13 United States taxpayer-funded research institutions
14 has benefitted China.

15 (4) How the Government of China and the Chi-
16 nese Communist Party have used United States tax-
17 payer-funded research, including as part of China’s
18 efforts to support “civil-military fusion” and human
19 rights abuses.

20 (c) DEFINITION.—In this section, the term “United
21 States taxpayer-funded research” means research—

22 (1) funded by a grant from the Federal Govern-
23 ment or a State government; or

1 (2) conducted by an institution that receives
2 funding from the Federal Government or a State
3 government.
