## AMENDMENT TO THE SENATE AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1

## OFFERED BY MS. WASSERMAN SCHULTZ OF FLORIDA

At the end of Title VII, Subtitle B add the following new section:

Sec. 71204. This Act, and the amendments made by this Act, shall only take effect upon the Secretary of Health and Human Services certifying in writing that the reductions and rescissions made by this Act will not:

- (1) reduce access to cancer screening, active treatment, or survivorship care for current Medicaid and Medicare beneficiaries;
- (2) directly or indirectly affect services offered by health care providers relating to preventive care, treatment, or survivorship services for current Medicaid and Medicare beneficiaries; or
- (3) increase the rate of delayed diagnoses or untreated cancers among current Medicaid and Medicare beneficiaries.

Not later than one year after enactment, GAO is directed to issue a report to Congress assessing whether any provisions in Subtitle B in Title VII result in a reduction in coverage or services available to Medicaid and Medicare beneficiaries currently undergoing cancer treatment or survivorship care.
