

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT**  
**117-20**  
**OFFERED BY MS. OCASIO-CORTEZ OF NEW YORK**

At the end of title X, add the following:

1 **SEC. 1003. CIVIL ACTIONS BY CONGRESS CONCERNING**  
2 **NEPOTISM IN THE CIVIL SERVICE.**

3 Section 3110 of title 5, United States Code, is  
4 amended by adding at the end the following:

5 “(f) CAUSE OF ACTION.—(1) The House of Rep-  
6 resentatives or the Senate may bring a civil action against  
7 any person for a violation of this section.

8 “(2) In any civil action described in paragraph (1),  
9 the following rules shall apply:

10 “(A) The action shall be filed before the United  
11 States District Court for the District of Columbia.

12 “(B) The action shall be heard by a three-judge  
13 court convened pursuant to section 2284 of title 28.

14 It shall be the duty of such court to advance on the  
15 docket and to expedite to the greatest possible extent  
16 the disposition of any such action. Such action shall  
17 be reviewable only by appeal directly to the Supreme  
18 Court of the United States. Such appeal shall be  
19 taken by the filing of a notice of appeal within 10

1 days, and the filing of a jurisdictional statement  
2 within 30 days, of the entry of the final decision.

3 “(C) It shall be the duty of the Supreme Court  
4 of the United States to advance on the docket and  
5 to expedite to the greatest possible extent the dis-  
6 position of any such action and appeal.

7 “(3) If the court determines that a violation of this  
8 section has occurred, the court shall issue an order enjoin-  
9 ing the course of conduct found to constitute the viola-  
10 tion.”.
