Page 7, line 9, strike the closing quotation mark and the second period.

Page 7, insert after line 9 the following:

1 “(4) OBLIGATION TO NOTIFY FOR FEDERAL OF-
2 FICEHOLDERS.—

3 “(A) OBLIGATION.—Not later than 3 days
4 after a reportable foreign contact, each Federal
5 officeholder shall notify the applicable ethics of-
6 ficial of the reportable foreign contact and pro-
7 vide a summary of the circumstances with re-
8 spect to such reportable foreign contact, includ-
9 ing the following information:

10 “(i) The date, time, and location of
11 the contact.

12 “(ii) The identity of the individuals
13 involved.

14 “(iii) A description of the contact, in-
15 cluding the nature of any contribution, do-
16 nation, expenditure, disbursement, or solie-

1 itation involved and the nature of any ac-
2 tivity described in paragraph (3)(A)(ii)(II)
3 involved.

4 “(B) FEDERAL OFFICEHOLDER DE-
5 FINED.—In this paragraph, the term ‘Federal
6 officeholder’ means any of the following:

7 “(i) The President.

8 “(ii) The Vice President.

9 “(iii) A Senator.

10 “(iv) A Member of the House of Rep-
11 resentatives, including a Delegate or Resi-
12 dent Commissioner to the Congress.

13 “(C) APPLICABLE ETHICS OFFICIAL DE-
14 FINED.—In this paragraph, the term ‘applicable
15 ethics official’ means the following:

16 “(i) In the case of the President or
17 the Vice President, the Director of the Of-
18 fice of Government Ethics.

19 “(ii) In the case of a Senator, the Se-
20 lect Committee on Ethics of the Senate.

21 “(iii) In the case of a Member of the
22 House of Representatives, the Committee
23 on Ethics of the House of Representatives.

24 “(D) TREATMENT AS ADDITIONAL OBLIGA-
25 TION.—Nothing in this paragraph shall be con-

1 strued to waive the obligation of a Federal of-
2 ficeholder who is also a candidate or an official,
3 employee, or agent of a political committee to
4 meet the requirements of paragraph (2).”.
