## AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 118–36 OFFERED BY MR. OGLES OF TENNESSEE

At the end of subtitle B of title XII, add the following new section:

  (b) CERTIFICATION.—The President shall, in notifying Congress of any major non-NATO ally designation renewal under this section, concurrently certify that the state of Qatar offers no direct or indirect financial support for designated foreign terrorist organizations and agrees

- 1 to extradite to United States custody any foreign national
- 2 involved in the taking of United States hostages on or
- 3 after October 7, 2023.
