

AMENDMENT TO
RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 119–38
OFFERED BY MR. OLSZEWSKI OF MARYLAND

Add at the end the following:

1 **SEC. 4. GRANT PROGRAM FOR PROVISION OF STATE AND**
2 **TRIBAL IDENTIFICATION.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subtitle D of title II of the Help
4 America Vote Act of 2002 (Public Law 107–252; 52
5 U.S.C. 21001 et seq.) is amended by adding at the end
6 the following new part:

7 **“PART 7—GRANT PROGRAM FOR PROVISION OF**
8 **IDENTIFICATION**
9 **“SEC. 298. GRANT PROGRAM FOR PROVISION OF IDENTI-**
10 **FICATION.**

11 “(a) GRANTS TO STATES.—

12 “(1) IN GENERAL.—The Commission shall
13 make grants to each State that provides identifica-
14 tion described in paragraph (2) without charge to
15 any individual who—

16 “(A) is eligible for such identification; and

17 “(B) provides an attestation under penalty
18 of perjury that the individual cannot afford to

1 pay the fee otherwise charged by the State for
2 the provision of the identification.

3 “(2) IDENTIFICATION DESCRIBED.—An identi-
4 fication described in this subsection is—

5 “(A) a State-issued motor vehicle driver’s
6 license that includes a photo of the individual
7 and an expiration date; and

8 “(B) an identification card issued by a
9 State motor vehicle authority that includes a
10 photo of the individual and an expiration date.

11 “(b) GRANTS TO TRIBES.—

12 “(1) IN GENERAL.—The Commission shall
13 make grants to each Tribal government that pro-
14 vides identification described in paragraph (2) with-
15 out charge to any individual who—

16 “(A) is eligible for such identification; and

17 “(B) provides an attestation under penalty
18 of perjury that the individual cannot afford to
19 pay such fee.

20 “(2) IDENTIFICATION DESCRIBED.—An identi-
21 fication described in this subsection is an identifica-
22 tion document issued by a Tribal government that
23 includes a photo of the individual and an expiration
24 date.

1 “(3) TRIBAL GOVERNMENT.—In this sub-
2 section, the term ‘Tribal government’ means the gov-
3 erning body of any Indian or Alaska Native tribe,
4 band, nation, pueblo, village, or community that the
5 Secretary of the Interior acknowledges to exist as an
6 Indian tribe under the Federally Recognized Indian
7 Tribe List Act of 1994 (25 U.S.C. 479a et seq.).”.

8 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of contents
9 of such Act is amended by inserting after the item relating
10 to section 296 the following:

“PART 7—GRANT PROGRAM FOR PROVISION OF IDENTIFICATION

“Sec. 298. Grant program for provision of identification.”.
