

AMENDMENT TO
RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 119–38
OFFERED BY MR. OLSZEWSKI OF MARYLAND

Add at the end the following:

1 SEC. 4. SAME-DAY REGISTRATION AND REQUIREMENTS
2 WITH RESPECT TO PROVISIONAL VOTING.

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Title III of the Help America
4 Vote Act of 2002 (52 U.S.C. 21081 et seq.) is amended
5 by inserting after section 303A (as added by section
6 3(a)(1)) the following new section:

7 “SEC. 303B. SAME-DAY REGISTRATION AND CERTAIN RE-
8 QUIREMENTS WITH RESPECT TO PROVI-
9 SIONAL VOTING.

10 “(a) SAME-DAY REGISTRATION.—

11 “(1) IN GENERAL.—

12 “(A) REGISTRATION.—Each State shall
13 permit any eligible individual on the day of a
14 Federal election and on any day when voting,
15 including early voting, is permitted for a Fed-
16 eral election—

17 “(i) to register to vote in such election
18 at the polling place using a form that
19 meets the requirements under section 9(b)

1 of the National Voter Registration Act of
2 1993 (or, if the individual is already reg-
3 istered to vote, to revise any of the individ-
4 ual's voter registration information); and
5 “(ii) to cast a vote in such election.

6 “(B) EXCEPTION.—The requirements
7 under subparagraph (A) shall not apply to a
8 State in which, under a State law in effect con-
9 tinuously on and after the date of enactment of
10 this section, there is no voter registration re-
11 quirement for individuals in the State with re-
12 spect to elections for Federal office.

13 “(2) ELIGIBLE INDIVIDUAL.—For purposes of
14 this subsection, the term ‘eligible individual’ means,
15 with respect to any election for Federal office, an in-
16 dividual who is otherwise qualified to vote in that
17 election.

18 “(3) ENSURING AVAILABILITY OF FORMS.—The
19 State shall ensure that each polling place has copies
20 of any forms an individual may be required to com-
21 plete in order to register to vote or revise the indi-
22 vidual's voter registration information under this
23 subsection.

24 “(b) CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS WITH RESPECT TO
25 PROVISIONAL VOTING.—If a State has in effect a require-

1 ment that an individual present a government-issued
2 photo identification as a condition of voting in an election
3 for Federal office held in the State, an individual desiring
4 to cast a ballot in such election who does not present such
5 identification shall be permitted to cast a provisional ballot
6 with respect to the election under section 302(a) and the
7 individual's provisional ballot shall be counted as a vote
8 in that election in accordance with State law and pursuant
9 to the requirements of section 302 if the appropriate elec-
10 tion official of the State determines that the individual is
11 otherwise eligible under State law to vote in such election.

12 “(c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—Each State shall be re-
13 quired to comply with the requirements of this section for
14 the regularly scheduled general election for Federal office
15 occurring in November 2026 and for any subsequent elec-
16 tion for Federal office.”.

17 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of contents
18 of such Act is amended by inserting after the item relating
19 to section 303A (as added by section 3(a)(2)) the fol-
20 lowing:

“Sec. 303B. Same-day registration and certain requirements with respect to
provisional voting.”.
