

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 117-13**  
**OFFERED BY MS. OMAR OF MINNESOTA**

At the end of subtitle B of title XIII, add the following:

1 **SEC. 1325. REPORT ON SECURITY ASSISTANCE TO THE GOV-**  
2 **ERNMENTS OF MALI, GUINEA, AND CHAD.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 90 days after the  
4 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense  
5 and the Secretary of State shall jointly submit to the ap-  
6 propriate committees a report on security assistance pro-  
7 vided to the Governments of Mali, Guinea, and Chad for  
8 each of the fiscal years 2019, 2020, and 2021.

9 (b) ELEMENTS.—The report required by subsection  
10 (a) shall include the following:

11 (1) A list of units of such countries that have  
12 received or participated in Department of Defense-  
13 or Department of State-funded training, equipment,  
14 or other assistance programs in such fiscal years, in-  
15 cluding a full accounting of the specific programs  
16 under which such assistance was provided.

17 (2) The dollar amounts spent on such programs  
18 for each of such countries in such fiscal years.

1           (3) A list of individuals in such units involved  
2           in unconstitutional military seizures of or transfers  
3           of power in any of such countries.

4           (4) A list of units, if any, in each country that  
5           are currently prohibited from receiving assistance  
6           pursuant to section 362 of title 10, United States  
7           Code, or section 620M of the Foreign Assistance Act  
8           of 1961 (22 U.S.C. 2378d) (collectively known as  
9           the “Leahy Laws”).

10          (5) An assessment of the objectives of security  
11          training as it relates to professionalization, stability,  
12          and human rights and the extent to which such  
13          training has achieved those objectives in such fiscal  
14          years, including details of the metrics used to deter-  
15          mine success.

16          (6) Lessons learned from the unconstitutional  
17          military seizures of power in any of such countries  
18          and the ways in which such lessons are being and  
19          will be applied to ongoing and planned training, ca-  
20          pacity-building, and other security assistance initia-  
21          tives in the region.

22          (c) FORM.—The report required by subsection (a)  
23          shall be submitted in unclassified form, but may include  
24          a classified annex.

1 (d) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES

2 DEFINED.—In this section, the term “appropriate con-

3 gressional committees” means—

4 (1) the Committee on Armed Services and the

5 Committee on Foreign Affairs of the House of Rep-

6 resentatives; and

7 (2) the Committee on Armed Services and the

8 Committee on Foreign Relations of the Senate.
