3 (a) SAFE HARBOR FOR MAINTENANCE OF INFRA4 STRUCTURE.—Subsection (a) of section 203 of the Inter5 national Emergency Economic Powers Act (50 U.S.C.
6 1702) is amended by adding at the end the following new
7 paragraph:

8	"(4) In implementing the authority under para-
9	graph (1), the President shall allow for the expor-
10	tation of equipment and material to a territory that
11	is subject to the control of a person otherwise sub-
12	ject to sanctions under the laws of the United States
13	if the exporter certifies that such equipment or ma-
14	terial is intended for use in the maintenance, in such
15	territory, of—
16	"(A) civilian healthcare facilities;

17 "(B) water infrastructure;

18 "(C) civilian energy infrastructure; or

19 "(D) primary or secondary educational fa-20 cilities.".

1 (b) EXCEPTION FOR SUPPORT INCIDENTAL TO COM-2 MUNICATION INTENDED TO REDUCE CONFLICT OR AL-LEVIATE SUFFERING.—Subsection (b) of such section 203 3 is amended— 4 (1) in paragraph (3), by striking "; or" and in-5 6 serting a semicolon; 7 (2) in paragraph (4), by striking the period at the end and inserting "; or"; and 8 9 (3) by adding at the end the following new 10 paragraph: 11 "(5) any support provided to a foreign person 12 subject to sanctions under the laws of the United 13 States, including organizations designated as foreign 14 terrorist organizations under section 219(a)(1) of 15 the Immigration and Nationality Act, that is inci-16 dental to speech or communication with such person 17 for the purpose of— 18 "(A) reducing or eliminating the frequency 19 and severity of violent conflict, including by fos-20 tering diplomatic solutions to violent conflict; or 21 "(B) preventing or alleviating the suffering 22 of a civilian populations.".
