

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 117-20
OFFERED BY MS. OMAR OF MINNESOTA

Page 80, after line 20, add the following:

1 **SEC. ____ . ADDITIONAL REPORTS TO CONGRESS.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subsection (b) of section 204 of
3 the International Emergency Economic Powers Act (50
4 U.S.C. 1703) is amended—

5 (1) in the matter preceding paragraph (1), by
6 striking “to the Congress” and inserting “to the ap-
7 propriate congressional committees”;

8 (2) by redesignating paragraphs (4) and (5) as
9 paragraphs (9) and (10), respectively; and

10 (3) by inserting after paragraph (3) the fol-
11 lowing new paragraphs:

12 “(4) the goals and outcomes expected to be
13 achieved through such actions;

14 “(5) other tools considered to address the emer-
15 gency, and the reason for choosing to respond to
16 such emergency through the imposition of sanctions;

17 “(6) a list of other countries imposing sanctions
18 in accordance with the sanctions imposed by the
19 President or, if such sanctions are unilateral, an ex-

1 planation for why no other country has imposed
2 such sanctions;

3 “(7) the strategy of the President to provide
4 compliance guidance to entities in the private sector
5 (including financial institutions), humanitarian orga-
6 nizations, and peacebuilding organizations;

7 “(8) the criteria, if any, that a sanctioned per-
8 son must meet before any sanctions imposed in the
9 exercise of such authority with respect to such per-
10 son may be lifted;”.

11 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Such section 204 is
12 further amended by adding at the end the following new
13 subsection:

14 “(e) For purposes of this section, the term ‘appro-
15 priate congressional committees’ means—

16 “(1) the Committee on Foreign Affairs and the
17 Committee on Financial Services of the House of
18 Representatives; and

19 “(2) the Committee on Foreign Relations and
20 the Committee on Banking, Housing, and Urban Af-
21 fairs of the Senate.”.

22 (c) REPORT ON TREATY OBLIGATIONS.—Not later
23 than 90 days after the date of the enactment of this Act,
24 and annually thereafter, the Secretary of State and the
25 Secretary of the Treasury shall jointly submit to Congress

1 a report, which shall be submitted in unclassified form but
2 may include a classified annex, on the manner and extent
3 to which each action taken during the preceding 1-year
4 period using the authorities of the International Emer-
5 gency Economic Powers Act (50 U.S.C. 1701 et seq.) is
6 in compliance with the treaty obligations of the United
7 States.
