

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 118-36
OFFERED BY MS. OMAR OF MINNESOTA

At the end of subtitle B of title XVII, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 17 ____ . REPORT ON FOREIGN POLICY OF THE UNITED**
2 **ARAB EMIRATES WITH RESPECT TO CERTAIN**
3 **COUNTRIES.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 120 days after the
5 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of State
6 and Secretary of Defense shall jointly submit to the appropriate congressional committees a report on the foreign
7 policy of the United Arab Emirates with respect to certain
8 foreign countries, including—

10 (1) an assessment of the UAE’s provision of
11 military and security assistance, including arms
12 transfers, to Sudan, Ethiopia, Somalia, Libya, and
13 the Democratic Republic of the Congo;

14 (2) an assessment of whether any arms transfer
15 from the UAE to one or more countries listed in
16 paragraph (1) includes equipment of United States
17 origin;

18 (3) an assessment of whether any military and
19 security assistance from the UAE to one or more

1 countries listed in paragraph (1), including arms
2 transfers, have played a role in the commission of
3 gross human rights violations or violations of inter-
4 national law;

5 (4) an assessment of whether any military and
6 security assistance from the UAE to one or more
7 countries listed in paragraph (1), including arms
8 transfers, have gone to entities designated by the
9 United States as foreign terrorist organizations or to
10 individuals or entities otherwise subject to United
11 States sanctions; and

12 (5) an assessment of the UAE's role in gold
13 smuggling operations or other illegal resource ex-
14 traction from one or more countries listed in para-
15 graph (1), or from any other country in Africa.

16 (b) FORM.—The report required by subsection (a)
17 shall be submitted in unclassified form, but may include
18 a classified annex.

19 (c) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES DE-
20 FINED.—In this section, the term “appropriate congres-
21 sional committees” means—

22 (1) the Committee on Armed Services and the
23 Committee on Foreign Relations of the Senate; and

1 (2) the Committee on Armed Services and the
2 Committee on Foreign Affairs of the House of Rep-
3 resentatives.
