RECRUITMENT OF PHYSICIANS IN DEPARTMENT 1 2 OF VETERANS AFFAIRS. 3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 7402(b)(1) of title 38, United States Code, is amended— 4 (1) by inserting "or to be offered a contingent 5 6 appointment to such position," after "position,"; and 7 (2) by striking subparagraph (B) and inserting 8 the following new subparagraph (B): 9 "(B)(i) have completed a residency program 10 satisfactory to the Secretary; or 11 "(ii) with respect to an offer for a contingent 12 appointment upon the completion of a post-graduate 13 training program, complete such a residency pro-14 gram by not later than two years after the date of 15 such offer; and". 16 (b) Oversight of Graduate Medical Education 17 PROGRAMS.—The Secretary shall— (1) ensure that a recruiter or other similar offi-18 19 cial of each Veterans Integrated Service Network visits, not less than annually, each allopathic and os-20

teopathic teaching institution with a graduate med ical education program within the Network to re cruit individuals to be appointed to positions in the
 Veterans Health Administration; and
