3	(1) Elections for federal office.—Each

7	FICE.—Notwithstanding any other provision of law,
8	a State may not use any funds provided by the Fed-
9	eral Government directly for election administration
10	purposes unless such State certifies to the Election
11	Assistance Commission that the State holds open
12	primaries for elections for State and local office.
13	(b) Open Primaries Described.—For purposes of
14	this section, a State holds open primaries for an election
15	for an office if any individual who is registered to vote
16	in a general election for such office in the State may cast
17	a ballot in any primary election (including a primary elec-
18	tion held for the selection of delegates to a national nomi-
19	nating convention of a political party and a primary elec-

- 2 tion of individuals for election to the office of President)
- 3 held by any political party to nominate candidates for elec-
- 4 tion for such office, including a convention or caucus of
- 5 a political party which has authority to nominate a can-
- 6 didate.
- 7 (c) STATE DEFINED.—In this section, the term
- 8 "State" has the meaning given the term in section 901
- 9 of the Help America Vote Act of 2002 (52 U.S.C. 21141).
- 10 (d) Rule of Applicability.—Subsection (a) shall
- 11 apply with respect to elections held after the date of the
- 12 enactment of this Act.
