

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 119-**

**33**

**OFFERED BY MR. PALLONE OF NEW JERSEY**

At the end of subtitle J of title V, add the following  
new section:

1 **SEC. 5\_\_\_ . ISSUANCE OF SUNSCREEN TO MEMBERS OF THE**  
2 **ARMED FORCES.**

3 (a) **ISSUANCE REQUIRED.**—The Secretary of Defense  
4 shall ensure that all members of the Armed Forces are  
5 provided sunscreen.

6 (b) **REPORT.**—Not later than one year after the date  
7 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense  
8 shall submit to Congress a report that includes—

9 (1) an assessment of existing sun protection  
10 policies of the Armed Forces;

11 (2) an inventory of the availability of sunscreen  
12 and other sun-protective measures at military instal-  
13 lations and locations where members of the Armed  
14 Forces are deployed;

15 (3) a summary of education and training pro-  
16 grams related to ultraviolet exposure and skin can-  
17 cer prevention provided to members of the Armed  
18 Forces;

1           (4) available data on skin cancer incidence  
2           among members of the Armed Forces serving on ac-  
3           tive duty;

4           (5) recommendations to improve skin cancer  
5           prevention, early detection, and education efforts for  
6           members of the Armed Forces;

7           (6) cost estimates for expanding sunscreen ac-  
8           cess and implementing education programs; and

9           (7) an identification of barriers to implementa-  
10          tion of expanded sunscreen access and education  
11          programs, including—

12                 (A) procurement and supply chain chal-  
13                 lenges;

14                 (B) operational and training impacts;

15                 (C) uniform and equipment limitations;

16                 (D) training and readiness considerations;

17                 and

18                 (E) resource constraints.
