Amendment to Rules Comittee Print 117–13 Offered by Mr. Panetta of California

Add at the end of subtitle E of title III the following new section:

1 SEC. 3____. REPORT AND BRIEFING ON PROJECT PELE MO 2 BILE NUCLEAR MICROREACTORS.

3 (a) BRIEFING.—Not later than 180 days after the 4 date of enactment of this Act, the Director of the Strategic 5 Capabilities Office of the Department of Defense, in co-6 ordination with the Secretary of Energy, shall provide to the congressional defense committees a briefing on the de-7 velopment, and current and predicted progress, of the 8 9 "Project Pele" effort to design, build, and demonstrate a 10 prototype mobile nuclear microreactor.

(b) MATTERS.—The briefing under section (a) shallinclude a discussion of the following:

13 (1) Changes to previous deployment rationales14 or strategies.

(2) Proposed deployment locations for mobile
nuclear microreactors, both domestically and abroad.
(3) The safety and regulatory requirements of
the proposed mobile nuclear microreactors, both domestically and abroad.

2	to meet the energy needs of expeditionary and defen-

14	nities potentially affected by the deployment, or the
15	demonstration of the deployment, of mobile nuclear
16	microreactors.
17	(8) Security concerns related to potential adver-
18	sarial attacks on deployed mobile nuclear microreac-
19	tors or adversarial seizing of mobile nuclear micro-
20	reactors, and the radioactive fuel therein, for use in
21	radiological weapons.
22	(c) REPORT.—Not later than one year after the date
23	of enactment of this Act, the Director shall submit to the
24	congressional defense committees a report on the current
