

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 118-36
OFFERED BY MR. PAPPAS OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

At the end of subtitle A of title XVII, add the following:

1 **SEC. 17__ . REPORT ON ACCESS TO SENSITIVE DATA AND**
2 **WEAPONS BY TURKEY.**

3 (a) REPORT.—Not later than 1 year after the date
4 of the enactment of this Act, the Comptroller General of
5 the United States shall submit to the appropriate congress-
6 sional committees a report that includes the following:

7 (1) A determination of whether the Secretary of
8 State and the Secretary of Defense have, within the
9 preceding 180 days, created a plan to relocate sen-
10 sitive United States Government data and weapons
11 systems, including nuclear weapons and information
12 related to the F-35 program, that are in Turkey.

13 (2) If a plan described under paragraph (1) ex-
14 ists, a summary of such plan.

15 (b) ACCESS TO DATA AND RECORDS.—The Secretary
16 of Defense and the Secretary of State shall provide to the
17 Comptroller General sufficient resources and access to
18 technical data, individuals, organizations, and records re-

1 quired to complete the report required under subsection
2 (a).

3 (c) SUBMISSION OF COMMENTS.—The Secretary of
4 Defense and the Secretary of State may, not later than
5 30 days after the date on which the Comptroller General
6 submits the report required under subsection (a), submit
7 to the appropriate congressional committees comments re-
8 garding such report.

9 (d) FORM OF REPORT.—The report required by sub-
10 section (a) shall be submitted in unclassified form and
11 may contain a classified annex.

12 (e) BRIEFING.—The Comptroller General shall pro-
13 vide to the appropriate congressional committees and any
14 Member of Congress, upon request by such Member, a
15 briefing on—

16 (1) the information contained in the report re-
17 quired under subsection (a); and

18 (2) any information contained in the classified
19 annex authorized by subsection (d).

20 (f) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES DE-
21 FINED.—In this section, the term “appropriate congres-
22 sional committees” means—

23 (1) the Committee on Armed Services and the
24 Committee on Foreign Relations of the Senate; and

1 (2) the Committee on Armed Services and the
2 Committee on Foreign Affairs of the House of Rep-
3 resentatives.
