

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 118-36
OFFERED BY MR. PAPPAS OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

At the end of subtitle B of title XII, insert the following:

1 **SEC. 12 ____ . REPORT ON DEPLOYMENT OF RUSSIAN S-400**
2 **SYSTEM BY TURKEY.**

3 (a) REPORT.—Not later than 90 days after the date
4 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of State and
5 the Secretary of the Treasury, in coordination with the
6 Secretary of Defense, shall jointly submit to the appropriate congressional committees a report that includes the
7 following:
8

9 (1) An assessment of the impact of sanctions
10 imposed with respect to the Presidency of Defense
11 Industries of the Republic of Turkey, and with respect
12 to any person associated with such Presidency,
13 pursuant to section 231 of the Countering America's
14 Adversaries Through Sanctions Act (22 U.S.C.
15 9525).

16 (2) A list of nationals of Turkey and contractors
17 of the Government of Turkey operating in the
18 intelligence sector of the Russian Federation, the de-

1 fense sector of the Russian Federation, or a mate-
2 rials sector related to such defense sector.

3 (3) An analysis of the deployment of S-400 air
4 defense systems procured by the Turkish armed
5 forces from the Russian Federation.

6 (4) An assessment of the threat such deploy-
7 ment poses to the national security of the United
8 States.

9 (5) An assessment of the ability of the air force
10 of Turkey to remain interoperable with the air forces
11 and air defense forces of other members of the
12 North Atlantic Treaty Organization.

13 (b) FORM OF REPORT.—The report required by sub-
14 section (a) shall be submitted in unclassified form and
15 may contain a classified annex.

16 (c) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES DE-
17 FINED.—In this section, the term “appropriate congres-
18 sional committees” means—

19 (1) the Committee on Armed Services, the
20 Committee on Banking, Housing, and Urban Af-
21 fairs, and the Committee on Foreign Relations of
22 the Senate; and

23 (2) the Committee on Armed Services, the
24 Committee on Financial Services, and the Com-

1 mittee on Foreign Affairs of the House of Rep-
2 resentatives.
