

AMENDMENT

OFFERED BY MR. PAPPAS OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

Insert, at the appropriate place, the following:

1 **SEC. 1. FUNDING FOR COPS HIRING PROGRAM; FUNDING**
2 **FOR BYRNE JAG PROGRAM.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 100052 of the Act titled
4 “An Act to provide for reconciliation pursuant to title II
5 of H. Con. Res. 14” (Public Law 119–21) is amended—

6 (1) in the section heading, by striking “**U.S.**
7 **IMMIGRATION AND CUSTOMS ENFORCEMENT**”
8 and inserting “**COPS HIRING PROGRAM**”;

9 (2) by striking “In addition to” and inserting
10 “(a) IN GENERAL.—In addition to”;

11 (3) in subsection (a), as so designated—

12 (A) by striking “Secretary of Homeland
13 Security for U.S. Immigration and Customs
14 Enforcement” and inserting “Attorney Gen-
15 eral”; and

16 (B) by striking “September 30, 2029” and
17 all that follows through “removal proceedings”
18 and inserting the following: “September 30,
19 2030, for grants made pursuant to paragraphs
20 (1) and (2) of section 1701(b) of the Omnibus

1 Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968
2 (34 U.S.C. 10381(b)).

3 “(b) WAIVER.—For grants made from funds made
4 available under this section, the requirements of section
5 1701(g) of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets
6 Act of 1968 (34 U.S.C. 10381(g)) shall be waived for the
7 following jurisdictions:

8 “(1) A county, municipality, town, township,
9 village, parish, borough, or other unit of general gov-
10 ernment below the State level that employs fewer
11 than 175 law enforcement officers.

12 “(2) A Tribal government that employs fewer
13 than 175 law enforcement officers.”.

14 (b) FUNDING FOR BYRNE JAG PROGRAM.—Section
15 90003 of the Act titled “An Act to provide for reconcili-
16 ation pursuant to title II of H. Con. Res. 14” (Public Law
17 119–21) is amended to read as follows:

18 **“SEC. 90003. EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSIST-
19 ANCE GRANT PROGRAM.**

20 “In addition to any amounts otherwise appropriated,
21 there is appropriated to the Attorney General for the De-
22 partment of Justice for fiscal year 2025, out of any money
23 in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, to remain
24 available until September 30, 2029, \$45,000,000,000, for

1 the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant
2 Program.”.
