RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 118–11 OFFERED BY MR. PASCRELL OF NEW JERSEY

At the end of title IV, add the following:

1	SECTION HELICOPTER NOISE COMPLAINTS.
2	(a) Helicopter Noise Complaint Enforce-
3	MENT.—Section 46301 of title 49, United States Code,
4	is amended by striking "or section 47133" and inserting
5	"section 47133, or section 47512".
6	(b) Helicopter Noise Complaint Information
7	Sharing Database.—
8	(1) In general.—Subchapter I of chapter 475
9	of title 49, United States Code, is amended by add-
10	ing at the end the following new section:
11	"§ 47512. Helicopter noise complaint information
12	sharing database
13	"(a) In General.—The Administrator of the Fed-
14	eral Aviation Administration shall establish and maintain
15	a database for the Aircraft Noise Ombudsman to receive,
1516	a database for the Aircraft Noise Ombudsman to receive, collect, and provide access to information regarding heli-

1	"(1) IN GENERAL.—The Aircraft Noise Om-
2	budsman shall establish a process to receive com-
3	plaint information in accordance with paragraphs
4	(2) and (3) for the input of complaint information
5	as required by subsection (c).
6	"(2) Required submissions.—Such process
7	shall provide that, not later than 48 hours after an
8	owner or operator of a helicopter receives a com-
9	plaint from an individual, regardless of whether the
10	owner or operator who received such complaint is
11	the subject of that complaint, such owner or oper-
12	ator shall submit to the Aircraft Noise Ombudsman
13	such information provided in the complaint and any
14	other information as may be specified by the Air-
15	craft Noise Ombudsman, including—
16	"(A) whether such owner or operator is the
17	subject of the complaint; and
18	"(B) to the extent that the owner or oper-
19	ator is the subject of the complaint that is
20	being submitted, a description of any action
21	such owner or operator is taking or plans to
22	take to address the complaint.
23	"(3) Public submissions.—Such process shall
24	provide for a mechanism by which individuals may

1	directly submit a complaint pertaining to helicopter
2	noise to the Aircraft Noise Ombudsman.
3	"(c) Inputs Required.—Not later than 48 hours
4	after receiving a submission described in paragraphs (2)
5	and (3) of subsection (b), the Aircraft Noise Ombudsman
6	shall—
7	"(1) determine which owner or operator is the
8	subject of the submission;
9	"(2) determine whether the complaint that is
10	the subject of such submission is meritorious; and
11	"(3) input, with respect to any claim deter-
12	mined to be meritorious under paragraph (2), infor-
13	mation pertaining to such submission into the data-
14	base established by subsection (a).
15	"(d) Access.—
16	"(1) In general.—The Administrator of the
17	Federal Aviation Administration shall provide access
18	to the database established by subsection (a) to own-
19	ers or operators of helicopters to view submissions of
20	complaints pertaining to such owners or operators.
21	"(2) Privacy and indications of actions
22	BEING TAKEN.—Access pursuant to paragraph (1)
23	may be extended only to the extent necessary for an
24	owner or operator to—

1	"(A) view information included in submis-
2	sions pertaining to such owner or operator; and
3	"(B) pursuant to subsection (e)(2), add in-
4	formation relating to actions that may be taken
5	or intended to be taken to address such com-
6	plaints.
7	"(e) Notification.—
8	"(1) Notification by Aircraft noise om-
9	BUDSMAN.—In the case the Aircraft Noise Ombuds-
10	man inputs a complaint into the database that was
11	not submitted by an owner or operator of a heli-
12	copter that is the subject of the complaint, not later
13	than 48 hours after such complaint is so inputted,
14	the Aircraft Noise Ombudsman shall notify such
15	owner or operator that the complaint has been input
16	into the database.
17	"(2) Response by owner or operator.—
18	Not later than 48 hours of being notified of a com-
19	plaint pursuant to paragraph (1), that is a meri-
20	torious complaint, as determined by the Aircraft
21	Noise Ombudsman, an owner or operator of a heli-
22	copter shall input into the database an indication as
23	to whether such owner or operator is taking an ac-
24	tion to address such complaint.

1	"(f) EXCEPTION.—Subsections (b)(2), (d), and (e)
2	shall not apply with respect to complaints relating to heli-
3	copters owner or operated by a military department (as
4	defined in section 102 of title 5) or the Coast Guard.
5	"(g) Report.—Not later than 2 years after the date
6	of enactment of this section, the Administrator of the Fed-
7	eral Aviation Administration shall submit to the Com-
8	mittee on Transportation and Infrastructure for the
9	House of Representatives and the Committee on Com-
10	merce, Science, and Transportation for the Senate a re-
11	port that includes the following:
12	"(1) The number of complaints received by the
13	Aircraft Noise Ombudsman that were then directed
14	to the owner or operator of a helicopter who was the
15	subject of such complaint.
16	"(2) The number of complaints received by the
17	Aircraft Noise Ombudsman in which the appropriate
18	owner or operator of a helicopter could not be identi-
19	fied.
20	"(3) The number of complaints received by the
21	Aircraft Noise Ombudsman that were reported by—
22	"(A) an owner or operator of a helicopter
23	and
24	"(B) an individual.

1	"(4) The number of instances an owner or op-
2	erator of a helicopter indicated such owner or oper-
3	ated took an action to address a complaint.".
4	(2) Clerical amendment.—The analysis sub-
5	chapter I of chapter 475 of title 49, United States
6	Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
7	lowing:
	"47512. Helicopter noise complaint information sharing database.".
8	(c) Helicopter Registration Requirements.—
9	Section 44102 of title 49, United States Code, is amended
10	by adding at the end the following new subsection—
11	"(c) Submission and Verification of Informa-
12	TION.—
13	"(1) Individual sho has
14	registered a helicopter under subsection (a), and any
15	individual who has an ownership interest of at least
16	10 percent in a helicopter registered under such sub-
17	section, shall submit to the Administrator the name,
18	address, date of birth, driver's license or pilot's li-
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	cense, or both, of such individual, and any informa-
20	cense, or both, of such individual, and any informa- tion necessary as determined by the Administrator.

5	"(3) Verification.—The Administrator shall
6	verify the information submitted and eligibility of
7	entities registered under this subsection through an
8	independent review.".
9	(d) Dealers' Certificates of Registration.—
10	Section 44104 of title 49, United States Code, is amend-
11	ed—
12	(1) by striking "The Administrator" and insert-
13	ing the following:
14	"(a) In General.—The Administrator".
15	(2) in paragraph (1) by striking "and" at the
16	end;
17	(3) in paragraph (2) by striking the period and
18	inserting "; and"; and
19	(4) by adding at the end the following:
20	"(3) in the public interest for verifying any in-
21	formation dealers submit for the issuance of a deal-
22	er's certificate.
23	"(b) Information for the Issuance of Dealers'
24	CERTIFICATES.—For any regulations prescribed under
25	subsection (a)(2) for the issuance of a dealer's certificate

- 1 of registration, the Administrator shall additionally re-
- 2 quire the dealer to furnish such information as may be
- 3 required by the Administrator.".
