

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT**

**119-33**

**OFFERED BY MR. PATRONIS OF FLORIDA**

At the end of subtitle B of title XXVIII, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 28\_\_.** **INAPPLICABILITY OF NATIONAL HISTORIC**  
2 **PRESERVATION ACT TO CERTAIN MILITARY**  
3 **HOUSING.**

4 Section 307104 of title 54, United States Code, is  
5 amended to read as follows:

6 **“§ 307104. Inapplicability of division to White House,**  
7 **Supreme Court building, United States**  
8 **Capitol, and certain military housing**

9 “(a) IN GENERAL.—Nothing in this division applies  
10 to—

11 “(1) the White House and its grounds, the Su-  
12 preme Court building and its grounds; or

13 “(2) except as provided in subsection (b), any  
14 building or structure on a military installation that  
15 is or has ever been used as—

16 “(A) military unaccompanied housing; or

17 “(B) military family housing,

1       “(b) EXCEPTION.—The exception under subsection  
2 (a) shall not apply to—

3           “(1) any building or structure described in  
4 paragraph (2) of such subsection that is listed on  
5 the National Register of Historic Places as of Janu-  
6 ary 20, 2025; or

7           “(2) any such building or structure the Sec-  
8 retary of Defense specifically exempts from this pro-  
9 vision, subject to subsection (c).

10       “(c) LIMITATION.—

11           “(1) NUMBER OF EXEMPTIONS.—If the Sec-  
12 retary of Defense elects to make a discretionary ex-  
13 emption under subsection (b), the total number of  
14 discretionary exemptions may not exceed one-one-  
15 tenth of one percent of the total number of buildings  
16 or structures on military installations that are or  
17 ever have been used as military unaccompanied  
18 housing or military family housing.

19           “(2) MANAGEMENT OF EXEMPTED BUILD-  
20 INGS.—Any buildings or structures specifically ex-  
21 empted by the Secretary of Defense pursuant to sub-  
22 section (b)(1) shall be managed in accordance with  
23 this division unless or until the Secretary of Defense

- 1 elects to remove the discretionary exemption granted
- 2 to any such building or structure.”.
