

AMENDMENT TO
RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 118–10
OFFERED BY MRS. PELTOLA OF ALASKA

At the end of subtitle C of title III, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 3____. TREATMENT OF CERTAIN MATERIALS CONTAMI-**
2 **NATED WITH PERFLUOROALKYL SUB-**
3 **STANCES OR POLYFLUOROALKYL SUB-**
4 **STANCES.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Defense may
6 treat covered materials, including soils that have been con-
7 taminated with perfluoroalkyl substances or
8 polyfluoroalkyl substances, until the date on which the
9 Secretary adopts the final rule required under section
10 343(b) of the National Defense Authorization Act for Fis-
11 cal Year 2022 (Public Law 117–81; 10 U.S.C. 2701 note)
12 if—

13 (1) the treatment of such materials occurs
14 through the use of a thermal remediation technology
15 that has been approved by the Federal Government
16 or the government of the State in which such treat-
17 ment would occur; and

1 (2) the facility at which such treatment would
2 occur is using or has previously used, as of the date
3 of the enactment of this Act, such technology to
4 treat such materials for a Federal department or
5 agency.

6 (b) COVERED MATERIAL DEFINED.—In this section,
7 the terms “covered material” has the meanings given such
8 term in section 343(e) of the National Defense Authoriza-
9 tion Act for Fiscal Year 2022 (Public Law 117–81; 10
10 U.S.C. 2701 note).
