

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 27
OFFERED BY MS. PEREZ OF WASHINGTON

Add at the end of the bill the following:

1 (d) COMPREHENSIVE OPIOID ABUSE GRANT PRO-
2 GRAM.—

3 (1) IN GENERAL.—Section 3021(a) of the Om-
4 nibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968
5 (34 U.S.C. 10701(a)) is amended by inserting after
6 paragraph (10) the following:

7 “(11) Establishing new, or supporting and ex-
8 panding existing, multi-jurisdictional task forces and
9 regional consortia by providing hiring, retention,
10 training, equipment, and technology support to law
11 enforcement officers and other employees, except
12 that in the case of a recipient that is an Indian
13 tribe, only an Indian tribe that is the governing body
14 of any Indian or Alaska Native tribe, band, nation,
15 pueblo, village, community, component band, or com-
16 ponent reservation individually identified (including
17 parenthetically) on the list published under section
18 104 of the Federally Recognized Indian Tribe List
19 Act of 1994 (25 U.S.C. 5131) may use funds re-

1 ceived under this part for the purposes described in
2 this paragraph.’”.

3 (2) DEFINITIONS.—Section 3025 of the Omni-
4 bus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (34
5 U.S.C. 10705) is amended by adding at the end the
6 following:

7 “(9) The term ‘multi-jurisdictional task force’
8 means any local law enforcement entity comprised of
9 law enforcement officers from different State, local,
10 or Tribal law enforcement agencies, which may also
11 include other support staff members or law enforce-
12 ment partners at the Federal, State, or local level.

13 “(10) The term ‘regional consortia’ means any
14 law enforcement entity comprised of multi-jurisdic-
15 tional task forces across State lines.”.
