

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 119-33**  
**OFFERED BY MR. PERRY OF PENNSYLVANIA**

In title XVI, subtitle B, add at the end the following  
new section:

1 **SEC. 16 \_\_\_\_ . PILOT PROGRAM FOR AGENTIC AUTONOMOUS**  
2 **ORCHESTRATION OF OPEN-SOURCE INTEL-**  
3 **LIGENCE CAPABILITIES.**

4 (a) **ESTABLISHMENT.**—The Director of National In-  
5 telligence shall, in coordination with the Under Secretary  
6 of Defense for Intelligence and Security, establish and  
7 carry out a pilot program to develop and demonstrate au-  
8 tonomous, agent-based orchestration capabilities to sup-  
9 port open-source intelligence activities, including tasking,  
10 collection, processing, exploitation, and dissemination.

11 (b) **DESIGNATION OF PILOT LEAD.**—The Director  
12 shall designate an element of the intelligence community  
13 to serve as the lead for the pilot program. In making such  
14 designation, the Director shall consider the technical capa-  
15 bilities, existing infrastructure, and ability of the element  
16 to scale such capabilities across the intelligence commu-  
17 nity.

18 (c) **PRIORITY DESIGNATION.**—The Director shall  
19 designate the pilot program as a priority emerging tech-

1 nology initiative for the intelligence community's capabili-  
2 ties with respect to open-source intelligence, including  
3 publicly available information and commercially available  
4 information.

5 (d) FUNDING AND TRANSFER AUTHORITY.—Of the  
6 amounts authorized to be appropriated for the Office of  
7 the Director of National Intelligence, the Director of Na-  
8 tional Intelligence shall make available such amounts as  
9 are necessary to carry out the pilot program under this  
10 section. The Director shall transfer amounts made avail-  
11 able under this subsection to the element of the intel-  
12 ligence community designated under subsection (b) to  
13 serve as the lead for the pilot program. Amounts trans-  
14 ferred under this subsection shall be available for research,  
15 development, test, and evaluation and shall remain avail-  
16 able for obligation for a period of not less than two fiscal  
17 years.

18 (e) REQUIREMENTS.—In carrying out the pilot pro-  
19 gram, the Director, acting through the lead, shall—

20 (1) develop interoperable, scalable orchestration  
21 frameworks capable of integrating multiple data  
22 sources and analytic tools;

23 (2) ensure alignment with intelligence commu-  
24 nity enterprise architecture, data standards, and se-  
25 curity requirements;

1           (3) embed, during development, functionalities  
2           that enable compliance with applicable laws, regula-  
3           tions, policies, and guidelines;

4           (4) evaluate the effectiveness of such capabili-  
5           ties in improving timeliness, usability, and mission  
6           impact of open-source intelligence;

7           (5) assess the ability of such capabilities to sup-  
8           port open source intelligence production involving  
9           publicly available information and commercially  
10          available information;

11          (6) assess scalability of the capabilities; and

12          (7) identify opportunities to provide such capa-  
13          bilities as a service of common concern for the intel-  
14          ligence community.

15          (f) **TRANSITION DETERMINATION.**—Not later than  
16 two years after the date of the enactment of this Act, the  
17 Director shall—

18           (1) determine whether to transition the pilot  
19           program to an enduring capability; and

20           (2) if so, designate an executive agent respon-  
21           sible for programmatic sustained operations, fund-  
22           ing, and integration across the intelligence commu-  
23           nity.

24          (g) **CONGRESSIONAL OVERSIGHT.**—The Director  
25 shall keep the congressional intelligence committees fully

1 and currently informed of the activities of the pilot pro-  
2 gram, including major milestones, funding decisions, per-  
3 formance outcomes, and any determination under sub-  
4 section (f).
