

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 8595, AS REPORTED  
OFFERED BY MR. PERRY OF PENNSYLVANIA**

At the end of the bill (before the short title), add the following:

1 **SEC. \_\_. INAPPLICABILITY OF JACKSON-VANIK AMEND-**  
2 **MENT.**

3       The President is authorized to take such actions as  
4 may be necessary to make inapplicable for a period not  
5 to exceed three years the provisions of section 402 of the  
6 Trade Act of 1974 (19 U.S.C. 2432; commonly referred  
7 to as the “Jackson-Vanik Amendment”) to a foreign coun-  
8 try to which such provisions apply as of the day before  
9 the date of the enactment of this Act if the President de-  
10 termines that—

11           (1) the country has refused funding from the  
12       Government of the People’s Republic of China for its  
13       program known as the “Belt and Road Initiative” or  
14       is otherwise not participating in such program; and

15           (2) the country continues to meet the require-  
16       ments of paragraph (1) during such three-year pe-  
17       riod.
