

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 119–33**  
**OFFERED BY MR. PERRY OF PENNSYLVANIA**

At the end of subtitle B of title XVII, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 17 \_\_\_\_ . ENHANCED DEFENSE COOPERATION.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—During the 5-year period begin-  
3 ning on the date of the enactment of this Act, Taiwan  
4 shall be treated as if it were a country listed in the provi-  
5 sions of law described in subsection (b) for purposes of  
6 applying and administering such provisions of law.

7 (b) PROVISIONS OF LAW DESCRIBED.—The provi-  
8 sions of law described in this subsection are—

9 (1) subsections (b)(2), (d)(2)(B), (d)(3)(A)(i),  
10 and (d)(5) of section 3 of the Arms Export Control  
11 Act (22 U.S.C. 2753);

12 (2) subsections (e)(2)(A), (h)(1)(A), and (h)(2)  
13 of section 21 of such Act (22 U.S.C. 2761);

14 (3) the matter following subparagraph (P) of  
15 subsection (b)(1) and subsections (b)(2), (b)(6),  
16 (c)(2)(A), (c)(5), and (d)(2)(A) of section 36 of such  
17 Act (22 U.S.C. 2776);

18 (4) section 62(c)(1) of such Act (22 U.S.C.  
19 2796a(c)(1)); and

1           (5) section 63(a)(2) of such Act (22 U.S.C.  
2           2796b(a)(2)).

3           (c) CONTINUED APPLICATION.—The Secretary of  
4 State is authorized to continue to apply this section with  
5 respect to Taiwan for additional 5-year periods beginning  
6 after the end of the 5-year period described in subsection  
7 (a) if, with respect to each such additional 5-year period,  
8 the Secretary—

9           (1) determines that such continued application  
10          is in the national security interests of the United  
11          States; and

12          (2) submits such determination to the Com-  
13          mittee on Foreign Affairs of the House of Rep-  
14          resentatives and the Committee on Foreign Rela-  
15          tions of the Senate not later than 14 days before the  
16          start of such additional 5-year period.
