

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 6285, AS REPORTED  
OFFERED BY MR. PERRY OF PENNSYLVANIA**

Add at the end the following:

1 **SEC. 7. EXEMPTION FROM COASTWISE LAWS FOR VESSELS**  
2 **TRANSPORTING LIQUEFIED NATURAL GAS.**

3 (a) GENERAL ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS.—Sec-  
4 tion 12103 of title 46, United States Code, is amended  
5 by adding at the end the following:

6 “(d) EXCEPTION FOR VESSELS TRANSPORTING LIQ-  
7 UEFIED NATURAL GAS.—

8 “(1) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding subsection  
9 (a), a certificate of documentation may be issued  
10 under this chapter for any vessel transporting meth-  
11 ane, refrigerated liquid, commonly known as lique-  
12 fied natural gas.

13 “(2) CERTAIN VESSELS EXCLUDED.—Para-  
14 graph (1) shall not apply to—

15 “(A) a vessel that is owned, in whole or in  
16 part, by—

17 “(i) a Russian national; or

18 “(ii) the Government of the Russian  
19 Federation;

20 “(B) a Russian-flagged vessel;

1           “(C) a vessel for which any crewmember is  
2 a Russian national;

3           “(D) a vessel that is owned, in whole or in  
4 part, by—

5                 “(i) a Chinese national; or

6                 “(ii) the Government of the People’s  
7 Republic of China;

8           “(E) a Chinese-flagged vessel; or

9           “(F) a vessel for which any crewmember is  
10 a Chinese national.”.

11         (b)         COASTWISE         ENDORSEMENT.—Section  
12 12112(a)(2)(B) of title 46, United States Code, is amend-  
13 ed—

14                 (1) in clause (ii) by striking “or” at the end;

15                 (2) in clause (iii) by striking “and” at the end

16 and inserting “or”; and

17                 (3) by adding at the end the following:

18                 “(iv) transports methane, refrigerated liq-  
19 uid, commonly known as liquefied natural gas;  
20 and”.
