At the end of subtitle C of title V of division A, insert the following:

1 SEC. ____. REPEAL OF MILITARY SELECTIVE SERVICE ACT.

2 (a) REPEAL.—The Military Selective Service Act (50
3 U.S.C. 3801 et seq.) is repealed.

4 (b) TRANSFERS IN CONNECTION WITH REPEAL.— 5 Notwithstanding the proviso in section 10(a)(4) of the 6 Military Selective Service Act (50 U.S.C. 3809(a)(4)), the 7 Office of Selective Service Records shall not be reestab-8 lished upon the repeal of such Act. Not later than 180 9 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, the as-10 sets, contracts, property, and records held by the Selective 11 Service System shall be transferred to the Administrator of General Services upon the repeal of the Military Selec-12 13 tive Service Act. The Director of the Office of Personnel Management shall assist officers and employees of the Se-14 15 lective Service System to transfer to other positions in the executive branch. 16

17 (c) EFFECT ON EXISTING SANCTIONS.—Notwith-18 standing any other provision of law, a person may not be

denied a right, privilege, benefit, or employment position
 under Federal law on the grounds that the person, before
 the repeal of the Military Selective Service Act (50 U.S.C.
 3801 et seq.) by subsection (a), failed to present himself
 for and submit to registration under section 3 of such Act
 (50 U.S.C. 3802).
