

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 119-
28
OFFERED BY MR. PERRY OF PENNSYLVANIA**

Add at the end the following:

(h) ALIGNMENT OF RENEWABLE VOLUME OBLIGATIONS WITH ACTUAL ETHANOL CONSUMPTION.—

(1) IN GENERAL.—Section 211(o) of the Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C. 7545(o)) is amended by adding at the end the following new paragraph:

“(13) CONSUMPTION-BASED SETTING OF RENEWABLE VOLUME OBLIGATIONS.—

“(A) REQUIREMENT.—Notwithstanding any other provision of this subsection, the Administrator shall establish the applicable volume of renewable fuel for conventional biofuel for each compliance year at a level that does not exceed the most recent verifiable estimate of domestic consumption of ethanol in transportation fuel in the United States.

“(B) DATA SOURCE.—For purposes of this paragraph, the Administrator shall base such determination on the most recent annual data published by the Energy Information Administration, including—

“(i) national gasoline consumption; and

“(ii) total ethanol blended into finished motor gasoline.

“(C) METHODOLOGY.—In establishing the applicable volume under this paragraph, the Administrator shall utilize a transparent methodology that reflects actual market conditions, including fuel demand, blend limitations, and demonstrated consumption levels, and shall make such methodology publicly available not later than 60 days prior to finalizing the applicable volume.

“(D) PROHIBITION.—The Administrator may not set an applicable volume for conventional biofuel that relies on projected consumption levels that exceed demonstrated, historic

consumption as reflected in the data described in subparagraph (B).

“(E) UPDATES.—The Administrator shall annually update the applicable volume to reflect the most recent finalized data published by the Energy Information Administration.”.

(2) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section 211(o)(2)(A)(i) of the Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C. 7545(o)(2)(A)(i)) is amended by adding at the end the following: “Not later than 1 year after the date of enactment of the Farm, Food, and National Security Act of 2026, the Administrator shall revise the regulations under this paragraph to implement the requirements of paragraph (13).”.
