Amendment to H.R. 1526, as Reported Offered by Mr. Peters of California

Add, at the end of the bill, the following:

1 SEC. 3. SENSES OF CONGRESS.

2 (a) SEPARATION OF POWERS.—It is the sense of
3 Congress that the Constitution provides for the separation
4 of powers between the legislative, executive, and judicial
5 branches.

6 (b) RESPECT FOR THE JUDICIARY.— It is the sense
7 of Congress that the legislative branch shall respect these
8 separation of powers and shall not encroach on the powers
9 of the judiciary.
