

AMENDMENT TO
RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 116–57
OFFERED BY MR. PETERS OF CALIFORNIA

At the end of subtitle E of title XVII, insert the following:

1 SEC. 17 ____ . EXPANSION OF ELIGIBILITY FOR HUD–VASH.

2 (a) HUD PROVISIONS.—Section 8(o)(19) of the
3 United States Housing Act of 1937 (42 U.S.C.
4 1437f(o)(19)) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
5 lowing new subparagraph:

6 “(D) VETERAN DEFINED.—In this para-
7 graph, the term ‘veteran’ has the meaning given
8 that term in section 2002(b) of title 38, United
9 States Code.”.

10 (b) VHA CASE MANAGERS.—Subsection (b) of sec-
11 tion 2003 of title 38, United States Code, is amended by
12 adding at the end the following: “In the case of vouchers
13 provided under the HUD–VASH program under section
14 8(o)(19) of such Act, for purposes of the preceding sen-
15 tence, the term ‘veteran’ shall have the meaning given
16 such term in section 2002(b) of this title.”.

17 (c) ANNUAL REPORTS.—

1 (1) IN GENERAL.—Not less frequently than
2 once each year, the Secretary of Veterans Affairs
3 shall submit to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs
4 of the Senate and the Committee on Veterans' Af-
5 fairs of the House of Representatives a report on the
6 homelessness services provided under programs of
7 the Department of Veterans Affairs, including serv-
8 ices under HUD–VASH program under section
9 8(o)(1) of the United States Housing Act of 1937
10 (42 U.S.C. 1437f(o)(19)).

11 (2) INCLUDED INFORMATION.—Each such an-
12 nual report shall include, with respect to the year
13 preceding the submittal of the report, a statement of
14 the number of eligible individuals who were fur-
15 nished such homelessness services and the number of
16 individuals furnished such services under each such
17 program, disaggregated by the number of men who
18 received such services and the number of women
19 who received such services, and such other informa-
20 tion as the Secretary considers appropriate.
