

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 119-8
OFFERED BY MR. PFLUGER OF TEXAS

At the end of subtitle A of title XVII, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 17____. MODIFICATIONS TO AUTHORITY FOR TRANS-**
2 **FER AND SALE OF CERTAIN SURPLUS FIRE-**
3 **ARMS, AMMUNITION, AND PARTS.**

4 (a) MODIFICATIONS TO TRANSFER AUTHORITY.—

5 Section 40728 of title 36, United States Code, is amend-
6 ed—

7 (1) in subsection (h)—

8 (A) in paragraph (1), by inserting “surplus
9 caliber .45 M45/M45A1 pistols and spare parts
10 and related accessories and ammunition for
11 those pistols, that on the enactment of the Na-
12 tional Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal
13 Year 2026, are under the control of the Sec-
14 retary and are surplus to the requirements of
15 the Department of the Army,” after “surplus to
16 the requirements of the Department of the
17 Army,”;

18 (B) in paragraph (2), by inserting “, and
19 may not transfer more than 10,000 surplus cal-

1 iber .45 M45/M45A1 pistols,” after “may not
2 transfer more than 10,000 surplus caliber .45
3 M1911/M1911A1 pistols”; and

4 (C) by adding at the end the following new
5 paragraph:

6 “(3) The Secretary may further transfer to the cor-
7 poration, in accordance with the procedure prescribed in
8 this subchapter, surplus shotguns, including any shotguns
9 that are surplus to the requirements of the Center of Mili-
10 tary History and the Army Museum Enterprise, except for
11 any shotgun that is a modular ancillary addition to a serv-
12 ice rifle.”;

13 (2) in subsection (i)—

14 (A) in paragraph (1), by striking “Na-
15 tional Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal
16 Year 2018” and inserting “National Defense
17 Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2025”; and

18 (B) by adding at the end the following new
19 paragraphs:

20 “(3) Subject to paragraph (4), the Secretary of the
21 Navy may further transfer to the corporation, in accord-
22 ance with the procedure prescribed in this subchapter, sur-
23 plus caliber .45 M45/M45A1 pistols and spare parts and
24 related accessories and ammunition for those pistols, and
25 surplus shotguns (except for any shotgun that is a mod-

1 ular ancillary addition to a service rifle), that on the date
2 of the enactment of this paragraph are under the control
3 of the Secretary and are surplus to the requirements of
4 the Department of the Navy.

5 “(4) The Secretary of the Navy may not transfer
6 more than 10,000 surplus caliber .45 M45/M45A1 pistols
7 to the corporation during any year and may only transfer
8 such pistols as long as pistols described in paragraph (3)
9 remain available for transfer.”; and

10 (3) by adding at the end the following new sub-
11 sections:

12 “(j) AUTHORIZED AIR FORCE TRANSFERS.—(1)
13 Subject to paragraph (2), the Secretary of the Air Force
14 may transfer to the corporation, in accordance with the
15 procedures prescribed in this subchapter, surplus caliber
16 .45 M45/M45A1 pistols and spare parts and related acces-
17 sories and ammunition for those pistols, and surplus shot-
18 guns (except for any shotgun that is a modular ancillary
19 addition to a service rifle), that on the date of the enact-
20 ment of this paragraph are under the control of the Sec-
21 retary and are surplus to the requirements of the Depart-
22 ment of the Air Force.

23 “(2) The Secretary of the Air Force may not transfer
24 more than 10,000 surplus caliber .45 M45/M45A1 pistols
25 to the corporation during any year and may only transfer

1 such pistols as long as pistols described in paragraph (1)
2 remain available for transfer.

3 “(k) AUTHORIZED TRANSFERS BY OTHER FEDERAL
4 DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES.—(1) The head of any
5 Federal department or agency may transfer to the cor-
6 poration, in accordance with the procedure prescribed in
7 this subchapter, the firearms and ammunition specified in
8 paragraph (2) that, on the date of the enactment of this
9 subsection, are under the control of that department or
10 agency and are surplus to the requirements of that depart-
11 ment or agency.

12 “(2) The firearms and ammunition specified in this
13 paragraph are the following:

14 “(A) Any surplus caliber .45 M1911/M1911A1
15 pistols.

16 “(B) Any surplus caliber .45 M45/M45A1 pis-
17 tol.

18 “(C) Any surplus shotgun except for any shot-
19 gun that is modular ancillary addition to a service
20 rifle.

21 “(D) Any surplus caliber .22 or .30 caliber
22 rifle.

23 “(E) Any ammunition associated with a firearm
24 described in subparagraph (A) through (D).”.

1 (b) MODIFICATIONS TO SALE AUTHORITY.—Section
2 40732 of title 36, United States Code, is amended—

3 (1) by striking “, and caliber .45 M1911/
4 M1911A1 surplus pistols,” each place it appears and
5 inserting “, caliber .45 M1911/M1911A1 surplus
6 pistols, caliber .45 M45/M45A1 surplus pistols, and
7 surplus shotguns (except for any shotgun that is a
8 modular ancillary addition to a service rifle)”; and

9 (2) in subsection (d)—

10 (A) by striking “A person” and inserting
11 “(1) A person”; and

12 (B) by adding at the end the following new
13 paragraph:

14 “(2) A person who receives a caliber .45 M1911/
15 M1911A1 surplus pistol, a caliber .45 M45/M45A1 sur-
16 plus pistol, shotgun, or any ammunition, repair parts, or
17 supplies, under section 40728 of this title may sell, at fair
18 market value, such pistol, shotgun, ammunition, repair
19 parts, or supplies.”.
