At the appropriate place in subtitle B of title XIII, insert the following:

1	SEC UNITED STATES-ISRAEL MILITARY AIR REFUEL-
2	ING ACT OF 2022.
3	Not later than 90 days after the date of the enact-
4	ment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense, in concurrence
5	with the Secretary of State, shall provide to the Committee
6	on Foreign Relations of the Senate and the Committee
7	on Foreign Affairs of the House of Representatives a re-
8	port, including—
9	(1) an assessment of Israel's current oper-
10	ational requirement for aerial refueling and any gaps
11	in current or near-term capabilities available;
12	(2) the estimated date of delivery for KC-46
13	aircraft to Israel;
14	(3) an assessment of United States Air Force
15	contracting for KC-46 aircraft for Israel, including
16	any delays or possible process improvements;
17	(4) a detailed description of—

1	(A) actions the United States Government
2	is taking to expedite delivery, without adversely
3	impacting United States defense readiness;
4	(B) the feasibility and advisability of pro-
5	viding Israel an interim capability;
6	(C) additional actions that could be taken
7	to expedite delivery without adversely impacting
8	United States defense readiness and why the
9	respective actions have not been taken yet; and
10	(D) authorities or appropriations that Con-
11	gress could provide to expedite the delivery;
12	(5) a description of ongoing or potential meas-
13	ures associated with KC-46 aircraft to expedite the
14	attainment of operational capability once delivered,
15	including training with United States or allied forces
16	in advance on the same system;
17	(6) an assessment of future availability for pur-
18	chase of more KC-46 refueling tankers by Israel;
19	(7) an estimated timeframe for purchase and
20	delivery of such aircraft; and
21	(8) options to accelerate purchase and delivery
22	of such aircraft without adversely impacting United
23	States defense readiness.
