

AMENDMENT TO
RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 119-33
OFFERED BY MR. PFLUGER OF TEXAS

At the end of subtitle A of title X, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 10__ . CLASSIFICATION OF PASS-THROUGH FUNDING**
2 **WITHIN DEFENSE BUDGET MATERIALS.**

3 Chapter 9 of title 10, United States Code, as amend-
4 ed by section 1002, is further amended by adding at the
5 end the following new section:

6 **“§ 239f. Pass-through funding: classification within**
7 **defense budget materials**

8 “(a) INCLUSION IN DEFENSE BUDGET MATE-
9 RIALS.—The Secretary of Defense, in coordination with
10 the Under Secretary of Defense (Comptroller), shall en-
11 sure that, for each fiscal year, there is included with the
12 budget justification materials submitted to Congress in
13 support of the budget of the Department of Defense for
14 that fiscal year (as submitted with the budget of the Presi-
15 dent under section 1105(a) of title 31) an identification
16 of the total amount of pass-through funding requested,
17 disaggregated by military department and set forth sepa-
18 rately from the total amount of other funding requested.

1 “(b) PUBLICATION.—(1) Not later than 10 days after
2 the date on which the budget of the President for a fiscal
3 year is submitted to Congress pursuant to section 1105
4 of title 31, the Secretary of Defense shall make publicly
5 available on a website of the Department of Defense an
6 identification of the total amount of pass-through funding
7 requested, disaggregated by military department and set
8 forth separately from the total amount of other funding
9 requested.

10 “(2) On an annual basis, the Secretary of Defense
11 shall update the website under paragraph (1) to include
12 an identification of the total amount of such pass-through
13 funding spent each fiscal year, disaggregated by military
14 department.

15 “(c) PASS-THROUGH FUNDING DEFINED.—In this
16 section, the term ‘pass-through funding’ means funds that
17 are requested by one element of the Federal government
18 but will be used primarily by another element.”.
