At the appropriate place in title XII, insert the following:

1	SEC INDEPENDENT STUDY ON INTERAGENCY EFFORTS
2	TO COUNTER GRAY ZONE OPERATIONS OF
3	RUSSIA, CHINA, IRAN, AND NORTH KOREA.
4	(a) In General.—The Secretary of Defense shall
5	seek to enter into an agreement with federally funded re-
6	search and development center with relevant expertise to
7	conduct an independent study of interagency efforts to
8	counter gray zone operations of Russia, China, Iran, and
9	North Korea.
10	(b) MATTER TO BE INCLUDED.—The study described
11	in subsection (a) should include the following:
12	(1) An analysis of the current definition of
13	"gray zone activity" as defined in section 825 of the
14	Intelligence Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2022
15	(Public Law 117–103).
16	(2) A synopsis of the threat of gray zone oper-
17	ations of Russia, China, Iran, and North Korea, in-
18	cluding a case study of such operations with respect
19	to each such country.

1	(3) The results of relevant reports published by
2	the Comptroller General of the United States.
3	(4) A review of current government functions,
4	including interagency functions, designed to counter
5	gray zone operations of such countries.
6	(5) A review of how such current government
7	functions fit into the current National Security
8	Strategy and all relevant strategy documents across
9	the United States Government.
10	(6) Policy and legislative recommendations for
11	improvement of interagency efforts to counter gray
12	zone operations of such countries, to include an as-
13	sessment of a national coordination node (such as a
14	National Gray Zone Director) to analyze threats and
15	to synchronize all the elements of national power to
16	counter such gray zone operations.
17	(c) Report to Secretary.—Not later than 180
18	days after the date on which the Secretary of Defense en-
19	ters into an agreement with a federally funded research
20	and development center under subsection (a), the center
21	shall submit to the Secretary a report on the results of
22	the review conducted under such subsection.
23	(d) Report to Congress.—
24	(1) In general.—Not later than 30 days after
25	the date on which the Secretary of Defense receives

1	the report under subsection (c), the Secretary shall
2	submit the report to the appropriate congressional
3	committees.
4	(2) Appropriate congressional commit-
5	TEES DEFINED.—In this subsection, the term "ap-
6	propriate congressional committees" means—
7	(A) congressional defense committees;
8	(B) the Committee on Foreign Affairs and
9	the Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence
10	of the House of Representatives; and
11	(C) the Committee on Foreign Relations
12	and the Select Committee on Intelligence of the
13	Senate.
