AMENDMENT TO H.R. 7900 OFFERED BY MR. PHILLIPS OF MINNESOTA

At the end of subtitle C of title XII, add the following:

1 SEC. 13_. STATE DEPARTMENT AUTHORIZATION FOR PA 2 VILION AT EXPO 2025 OSAKA.

(a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding section 204 of
the Admiral James W. Nance and Meg Donovan Foreign
Relations Authorization Act, Fiscal Years 2000 and 2001
(22 U.S.C. 2452b), there is authorized to be appropriated
for each of fiscal years 2023 and 2024 funds for a United
States pavilion at Expo 2025 Osaka, subject to subsections (b) and (c).

10 (b) COST-SHARE REQUIREMENT.—Funds made avail-11 able pursuant to subsection (a) to the Department of 12 State for a United States pavilion at Expo 2025 Osaka 13 shall be made available on a cost-matching basis, to the 14 maximum extent practicable, from sources other than the 15 United States Government.

16 (c) NOTIFICATION.—

17 (1) IN GENERAL.—Funds made available pur18 suant to subsection (a) to the Department of State
19 for a United States pavilion at Expo 2025 Osaka

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1	may be obligated only after the appropriate congres-
2	sional committees are notified not less than 15 days
3	prior to such obligation.
4	(2) MATTERS TO BE INCLUDED.—Such notifi-
5	cation shall include the following:
6	(A) A description of the source of such
7	funds, including any funds reprogrammed or
8	transferred by the Department of State to be
9	made available for such pavilion.
10	(B) An estimate of the amount of invest-
11	ment such pavilion could bring to the United
12	States.
13	(C) A description of the strategy of the
14	Department to identify and obtain such match-
15	ing funds from sources other than the United
16	States Government, in accordance with sub-
17	section (b).
18	(D) A certification that each entity receiv-
19	ing amounts for a contract, grant, or other
20	agreement to construct, maintain, or otherwise
21	service such pavilion—
22	(i) is not in violation of the labor laws
23	of Japan, the Foreign Corrupt Practices
24	Act of 1977 (Public Law 95–213), and any
25	other applicable anti-corruption laws; and

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1	(ii) does not employ, or otherwise uti-
2	lize, a victim of trafficking (as defined in
3	section 103 of the Trafficking Victims Pro-
4	tection Act of 2000 (22 U.S.C. 7102)).
5	(d) FINAL REPORT.—Not later than 180 days after
6	the date on which a United States pavilion at Expo 2025
7	Osaka is opened, the Secretary of State shall submit to
8	the appropriate congressional committees a report that in-
9	cludes—
10	(1) the number of United States businesses
11	that participated in such pavilion; and
12	(2) the dollar amount and source of any match-
13	ing funds obtained by the Department.
14	(e) Appropriate Congressional Committees De-
15	FINED.—In this section, the term "appropriate congres-
16	sional committees" means the following:
17	(1) The Committee on Foreign Affairs and the
18	Committee on Appropriations of the House of Rep-
19	resentatives.
20	(2) The Committee on Foreign Relations and
21	the Committee on Appropriations of the Senate.
22	(f) SUNSET.—This section ceases to be effective on
23	December 31, 2025.
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
