At the end of title LIII of division E of the bill, add the following:

SEC. 5306. AQUA ALERT NOTIFICATION SYSTEM PILOT PRO GRAM.

(a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 2 years after the
date of enactment of this Act, the Commandant of the
Coast Guard shall, subject to the availability of appropriations, establish a pilot program to improve the issuance
of alerts to facilitate cooperation with the public to render
aid to distressed individuals under section 521 of title 14,
United States Code.

(b) PILOT PROGRAM CONTENTS.—The pilot program
established under subsection (a) shall, to the maximum
extent possible—

(1) include a voluntary opt-in program under
which members of the public may receive notifications on cellular devices regarding Coast Guard activities to render aid to distressed individuals under
section 521 of title 14, United States Code;

(2) cover areas located within the area of re sponsibility of 3 different Coast Guard sectors in di verse geographic regions; and

4 (3) provide that the dissemination of an alert
5 be limited to the geographic areas most likely to fa6 cilitate the rendering of aide to distressed individ7 uals.

8 (c) CONSULTATION WITH OTHER AGENCIES, 9 STATES, TERRITORIES, AND POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS.— In developing the pilot program under subsection (a), the 10 Commandant shall consult any relevant Federal agency, 11 12 State, Territory, Tribal government, possession, or political subdivision. 13

14 (d) REPORT TO CONGRESS.—Not later than 2 years 15 after the date of enactment of this Act, and annually thereafter through 2026, the Commandant shall submit 16 to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure 17 18 of the House of Representatives and the Committee on 19 Commerce, Science, and Transportation of the Senate, 20 and make available to the public, a report on the imple-21 mentation of this Act.

22 (e) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—

(1) IN GENERAL.—There is authorized to be
appropriated to carry out this Act \$3,000,000 to the

- Commandant for each of fiscal years 2023 through
 2026.
- 3 (2) AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS.—Amounts appro4 priated pursuant to paragraph (1) shall remain
 5 available until expended.
