At the end of subtitle A of title XVII, add the following new section:

SEC. 17 REPORT ON SECURITY IMPLICATIONS OF CLI-
MATE CHANGE.
(a) Report Required.—Not later than one year
after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary
of Defense shall submit to the congressional defense com-
mittees a report on the security implications of climate
change.
(b) Elements.—The report under subsection (a)
shall include—
(1) an assessment of the security implications
of climate change, including an assessment of the ef-
fects of climate change on—
(A) each combatant command;
(B) international transboundary risks; and
(C) each line of effort set forth in the most
recent national defense strategy provided under
section 113(g) of title 10, United States Code;

1	(2) an analysis of the security implications de-
2	scribed in paragraph (1) if global temperatures were
3	to increase by one to two degrees celsius above pre-
4	industrial levels; and
5	(3) an analysis of the security implications of
5	climate change if global temperatures were to in-
7	crease by two to four degrees celsius above pre-in-
8	dustrial levels.
