

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 116-**57****OFFERED BY MR. PHILLIPS OF MINNESOTA**

At the end of subtitle F of title V, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 5____. REPORT ON OFFICER TRAINING IN IRREGULAR**
2 **WARFARE.**

3 (a) REPORT REQUIRED.—Not later than 180 days
4 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary
5 of Defense shall submit to the appropriate congressional
6 committees a report on the training in irregular warfare,
7 if any, provided to officers of the Armed Forces as part
8 of the regular course of instruction for such officers.

9 (b) ELEMENTS.—The report under subsection (a)
10 shall include—

11 (1) the level of instruction in irregular warfare
12 typically provided to officers;

13 (2) the number of hours of instruction at each
14 level; and

15 (3) a description of the subject areas covered by
16 the instruction.

17 (c) EXCLUSION OF SPECIALIZED TRAINING.—The re-
18 port under subsection (a) shall not include information on

1 specialized or branch-specific training in irregular warfare
2 provided to certain officers as part of a specialized course
3 of instruction.

4 (d) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

5 (1) The term “appropriate congressional com-
6 mittees” means—

7 (A) the Committee on Armed Services and
8 the Committee on Foreign Relations of the Sen-
9 ate; and

10 (B) the Committee on Armed Services and
11 the Committee on Foreign Affairs of the House
12 of Representatives.

13 (2) The term “irregular warfare” has the
14 meaning given that term in the Joint Operating
15 Concept of the Department of Defense titled “Irreg-
16 ular Warfare: Countering Irregular Threats”,
17 version 2.0, dated May 17, 2010.
