At the end of subtitle F of title V, add the following new section:

## 1 SEC. 5\_\_\_\_. REPORT ON OFFICER TRAINING IN IRREGULAR 2 WARFARE.

3 (a) REPORT REQUIRED.—Not later than 180 days
4 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary
5 of Defense shall submit to the appropriate congressional
6 committees a report on the training in irregular warfare,
7 if any, provided to officers of the Armed Forces as part
8 of the regular course of instruction for such officers.

9 (b) ELEMENTS.—The report under subsection (a)10 shall include—

- (1) the level of instruction in irregular warfaretypically provided to officers;
- 13 (2) the number of hours of instruction at each14 level; and
- 15 (3) a description of the subject areas covered by16 the instruction.

17 (c) EXCLUSION OF SPECIALIZED TRAINING.—The re-18 port under subsection (a) shall not include information on

specialized or branch-specific training in irregular warfare 1 2 provided to certain officers as part of a specialized course 3 of instruction. 4 (d) DEFINITIONS.—In this section: (1) The term "appropriate congressional com-5 mittees" means-6 7 (A) the Committee on Armed Services and 8 the Committee on Foreign Relations of the Sen-9 ate; and 10 (B) the Committee on Armed Services and 11 the Committee on Foreign Affairs of the House 12 of Representatives. The term "irregular warfare" has the 13 (2)meaning given that term in the Joint Operating 14 15 Concept of the Department of Defense titled "Irreg-Countering 16 ular Warfare: Irregular Threats", 17 version 2.0, dated May 17, 2010.
