Page 158, after line 19, insert the following:

SEC. 319. REPORT ON EFFECTS OF CLIMATE CHANGE ON 2 DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE. 3 (a) Report Required.—Not later than one year after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary 5 of Defense shall submit to the Committees on Armed Services of the Senate and the House of Representatives a report on vulnerabilities to military installations and combatant commander requirements resulting from climate change over the next 20 years. 10 (b) Elements.—The report on vulnerabilities to military installations and combatant commander requirements required by subsection (a) shall include the fol-12 lowing: 13

(1) To identify installations for which climate

change is expected to negatively impact the installa-

1	tion's mission or core activities based on the effects
2	of rising sea tides, increased flooding, drought
3	desertification, wildfires, thawing permafrost, and
4	any other categories the Secretary determines nec-
5	essary.
6	(2) An overview of mitigations that may be nec-
7	essary to ensure the continued operational viability
8	and to increase the resiliency of the identified vul-
9	nerable military installations and the cost of such
10	mitigations.
11	(3) A discussion of the climate-change related
12	effects on the Department, including the increase in
13	the frequency of humanitarian assistance and dis-
14	aster relief missions and the theater campaign plans
15	contingency plans, and global posture of the combat-
16	ant commanders.
17	(4) An overview of mitigations that may be nec-
18	essary to ensure mission resiliency and the cost of
19	such mitigations.
20	(c) FORM.—The report required under subsection (a)
21	shall be submitted in unclassified form, but may contain
22	a classified annex.
