

AMENDMENT TO DIVISION D OF THE RULES
COMMITTEE PRINT 117-55
OFFERED BY MR. PHILLIPS OF MINNESOTA

At the end of division D (before the short title), insert the following:

1 **TITLE IX—ENTREPRENEURSHIP EDUCATION**
2 **FOR DISADVANTAGED YOUTH**

3 **SEC. 901. (a) IN GENERAL.**—The Administrator of
4 the Small Business Administration shall—

5 (1) develop a curriculum for volunteers with the
6 SCORE program to teach entrepreneurship to students
7 served by community learning centers; and

8 (2) in developing the curriculum required under para-
9 graph (1), collaborate with education specialists, entrepre-
10 neurship groups, business groups, and groups with experi-
11 ence serving underrepresented children.

12 (b) **CONSULTATION.**—The Administrator of the
13 Small Business Administration, in consultation with the
14 Secretary of Education, shall develop and implement a
15 strategy to teach the curriculum developed under para-
16 graph (1) to the students described in that paragraph
17 through community learning centers;

1 (c) COLLABORATION WITH OTHER PROGRAMS.—In
2 teaching the curriculum developed under subsection (a),
3 volunteers with the SCORE program are encouraged to
4 collaborate with other entrepreneurial development pro-
5 grams of the Small Business Administration and other
6 agencies, including—

7 (1) small business development centers de-
8 scribed in section 21 of the Small Business Act (15
9 U.S.C. 648);

10 (2) women’s business centers operating under
11 section 29 of the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C.
12 656); and

13 (3) centers overseen by the Minority Business
14 Development Agency (established under section
15 100002 of the Minority Business Development Act
16 of 2021 (15 U.S.C. 9501)).

17 (d) SCORE PROGRAM.—Section 8(b)(1)(B) of the
18 Small Business Act (15 U.S.C. 637(b)(1)(B)) is amended,
19 in the first sentence, by inserting before the period at the
20 end the following: “and to teach students entrepreneurship
21 through community learning centers (as defined in section
22 4201(b) of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act
23 of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 7171(b)))”.

1 (e) COMMUNITY LEARNING CENTERS.—Part B of
2 title IV of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act
3 of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 7171 et seq.) is amended—

4 (1) in section 4201(a)(2) (20 U.S.C.
5 7171(a)(2)), by inserting “entrepreneurship edu-
6 cation taught through volunteers with the SCORE
7 program (as defined in section 8(b)(1)(B) of the
8 Small Business Act (15 U.S.C. 637(b)(1)(B))),”
9 after “apprenticeship programs,”; and

10 (2) in section 4205(a) (20 U.S.C. 7175(a))—

11 (A) in paragraph (13), by striking “and”
12 at the end;

13 (B) in paragraph (14), by striking the pe-
14 riod at the end and inserting “; and”; and

15 (C) by adding at the end the following:

16 “(15) entrepreneurship education described in
17 section 4201(a)(2).”.

18 (f) REPORT.—Not later than 1 year after the date
19 of enactment of this Act, and every 2 years thereafter,
20 the Administrator of the Small Business Administration
21 shall submit to the Committee on Small Business and En-
22 trepreneurship of the Senate and the Committee on Small
23 Business of the House of Representatives a report that—

24 (1) identifies instance of the use of the cur-
25 riculum described in subsection (a) by the SCORE

1 program and a community learning center during
2 the preceding 2-year period;

3 (2) documents the use of funds by the SCORE
4 program, and adherence by the SCORE program to
5 contract award and procurement procedures, relat-
6 ing to the implementation of this Act;

7 (3) documents any training or guidance pro-
8 vided to SCORE program chapter leadership on
9 properly using funds provided to carry out this Act;

10 (4) estimates the number of students who were
11 reached through the entrepreneurship curriculum de-
12 veloped under subsection (a);

13 (5) identifies any barriers to reaching additional
14 students; and

15 (6) identifies any plans for improving the cur-
16 riculum or implementing the strategy developed
17 under subsection (a).

18 (g) DEFINITIONS.—In this Act—

19 (1) the term “community learning center” has
20 the meaning given the term in section 4201(b) of
21 the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of
22 1965 (20 U.S.C. 7171(b)); and

23 (2) the term “SCORE program” means the
24 Service Corps of Retired Executives described in sec-

1 tion 8(b)(1)(B) of the Small Business Act (15
2 U.S.C. 637(b)(1)(B)).
