4 (a) SENSE OF CONGRESS.—It is the Sense of Con5 gress that—

6 (1)the nature of, and operations at, the 7 Relocatable Over-the-Horizon Radar (ROTHR) facil-8 ity on the island of Vieques, Puerto Rico is, or is the 9 functional equivalent of, a Government-owned but 10 privately operated installation, otherwise commonly 11 referred to in Federal acquisition regulations as a 12 Government-owned, contractor operated installation; 13 (2) the exception to the prohibition on contracts 14 for performance of firefighting and security-guard 15 functions provided by paragraph (2), subsection (b), 16 section 2465, title 10, United States Code, for con-

17 tracts to be carried out on a Government-owned but18 privately operated installation applies to the

3 (3) the Department of the Navy should make 4 every reasonable effort to hire local residents of 5 Vieques for employment at the ROTHR facility on 6 the island, including for security-guard functions 7 that the Department may require at the facility; and 8 (4) in the event that the Department of the 9 Navy elects to convert performance of security-guard 10 functions at the Vieques ROTHR facility from con-11 tract positions to federal civilian positions, the De-12 partment should avail itself of all authorities and 13 discretion to hire qualified residents of Vieques who 14 have performed those same functions at the facility 15 as contract employees.

(b) EXPRESS AUTHORITY TO CONTRACT.—The Secretary of the Navy may enter into a contract for the performance of firefighting and security-guard functions at
the Relocatable Over-the-Horizon Radar (ROTHR) site on
the island of Vieques, Puerto Rico.

(c) INAPPLICABILITY OF LIMITATION ON USE OF
FUNDS.—Section 2465 of title 10, United States Code,
shall not apply with respect to the authority provided in
subsection (b).
