MOTION TO CONCUR IN SENATE AMENDMENT TO H.R. 644 WITH AN AMENDMENT OFFERED BY MR. PITTS OF PENNSYLVANIA

Mr. Pitts moves that the House concur in the Senate amendment with an amendment, as follows:

At the end of title IX (page 227, after line 10), add the following:

1	SEC. 915. PROHIBITION ON IMPORTS OF NATURAL RE-
2	SOURCES FROM DISPUTED NON-SELF-GOV-
3	ERNING REGIONS AND TERRITORIES.
4	(a) Prohibition.—The President shall prohibit the
5	importation into the United States of any natural re-
6	source, from whatever source, that has been extracted
7	from a disputed non-self-governing region or territory un-
8	less the President certifies to Congress that such natural
9	resources were extracted with the consent of the people
10	of such non-self-governing region or territory.
11	(b) Definition.—In subsection (a), the term "dis-
12	puted non-self-governing region or territory' means—
13	(1) the disputed territory of Western Sahara in
14	the Maghreb region of North Africa; or

1	(2) the administrative division of Donetsk,
2	Luhansk, or Kharkiv of Ukraine, or any other ad-
3	ministrative division of Ukraine that the President
4	determines to be occupied by forces of the Russian
5	Federation.
6	(c) Effective Date.—This section shall take effect
7	on the date of the enactment of this Act and shall apply
8	with respect to the importation into the United States of
9	any natural resource, from whatever source, on or after
10	such date of enactment.
