At the end of subtitle A of title VII, insert the following:

1 SEC. 7___. IMPROVEMENTS RELATING TO ADMINISTRA 2 TION OF TRICARE PROGRAM IN UNITED 3 STATES VIRGIN ISLANDS.

4 (a) IMPROVEMENTS.—Chapter 55 of title 10, United
5 States Code, is amended by inserting after section 1076f
6 the following new section:

7 "§ 1076g. TRICARE program: administration in 8 United States Virgin Islands

9 "(a) AVAILABILITY OF TRICARE PRIME.—In desig-10 nating geographical areas under section 1097(b)(3) of this 11 title, the Secretary of Defense shall designate areas in the 12 United States Virgin Islands in a similar manner used to 13 designate areas in the several States.

14 "(b) EXPANSION OF TRAVEL BENEFITS.—

"(1) In providing travel and transportation allowances under section 1074i of this title, the Secretary of Defense shall ensure that individuals located in the United States Virgin Islands who, but

for such location, would be eligible to receive such
 allowances pursuant to such section are eligible to
 receive such allowances.

4 "(2) The Secretary may revise regulations pre5 scribed under section 464 of title 37, or prescribe
6 such new regulations, as may be necessary for the
7 administration of paragraph (1).

8 "(c) Health Information Exchange.—

9 "(1) The Director of the Federal Electronic 10 Health Record Modernization Office shall coordinate 11 with the Chief Public Health Officer and the Com-12 missioner of the Department of Health of the United 13 States Virgin Islands for the purpose of sharing 14 health information through the Joint Health Infor-15 mation Exchange, or a successor initiative.

"(2) In this subsection, the term 'Federal Electronic Health Record Modernization Office' means
the office established under section 1635(b) of the
Wounded Warrior Act (10 U.S.C. 1071 note).

"(d) ESTABLISHMENT OF PRIME SERVICE AREA.—
The Secretary shall take steps to ensure the establishment
of Prime Service Areas in the United States Virgin Islands, regardless of proximity to a military medical treatment facility.".

(b) REPORT.—Not later than 6 months after the date
 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense
 shall submit to the congressional defense committees a re port on the progress of the Secretary in carrying out the
 implementation of TRICARE Prime expansion in the
 United States Virgin Islands.
