

AMENDMENT TO
RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 117-20
OFFERED BY MR. CICILLINE OF RHODE ISLAND

Add at the end of part 1 of subtitle B of division
B the following new section:

1 SEC. 516. WHITE HOUSE EMPLOYEE INFORMATION.

2 Not later than 90 days after the date of the enact-
3 ment of this Act and updated not less frequently than an-
4 nually thereafter, the Executive Office of the President
5 shall make available on a publicly available website in an
6 easily searchable and downloadable format the following
7 information:

8 (1) The annual salary of each White House em-
9 ployee, which shall be updated quarterly, and the fol-
10 lowing:

11 (A) The number of employees who are paid
12 at a rate of basic pay equal to or greater than
13 the rate of basic pay then currently paid for
14 level V of the Executive Schedule of section
15 5316 of title 5 and who are employed in the
16 White House Office, the Executive Residence at
17 the White House, the Office of the Vice Presi-
18 dent, the Domestic Policy Staff, or the Office of

1 Administration, and the aggregate amount paid
2 to such employees.

3 (B) The number of employees employed in
4 such offices who are paid at a rate of basic pay
5 which is equal to or greater than the minimum
6 rate of basic pay then currently paid for GS-
7 16 of the General Schedule of section 5332 of
8 title 5, United States Code, but which is less
9 than the rate then currently paid for level V of
10 the Executive Schedule of section 5316 of such
11 title and the aggregate amount paid to such
12 employees.

13 (C) The number of employees employed in
14 such offices who are paid at a rate of basic pay
15 which is less than the minimum rate then cur-
16 rently paid for GS-16 of the General Schedule
17 of section 5332 of title 5, United States Code,
18 and the aggregate amount paid to such employ-
19 ees.

20 (D) The number of individuals detailed
21 under section 112 of title 3, United States
22 Code, for more than 30 days to each such of-
23 fice, the number of days in excess of 30 each
24 individual was detailed, and the aggregate

1 amount of reimbursement made as provided by
2 the provisions of section 112 of such title.

3 (E) The number of individuals whose serv-
4 ices as experts or consultants are procured
5 under chapter 2 title 3, United States Code, for
6 service in any such office, the total number of
7 days employed, and the aggregate amount paid
8 to procure such services.

9 (2) The most recent financial disclosure state-
10 ment for each White House employee filed pursuant
11 to the Ethics in Government Act of 1978 (5 U.S.C.
12 App.), which shall be updated annually.
