

AMENDMENT TO
RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 117-20
OFFERED BY MR. CICILLINE OF RHODE ISLAND

Add at the end of part 1 of subtitle B of division
B the following new section:

1 **SEC. 516. WHITE HOUSE VISITOR LOG AND EMPLOYEE IN-**
2 **FORMATION.**

3 (a) REQUIREMENT TO PUBLISH.—Except as provided
4 in subsection (b), not later than 90 days after the date
5 of the enactment of this Act, the Executive Office of the
6 President shall make available on a publicly available
7 website in an easily searchable and downloadable format
8 the following information:

9 (1) Visitor records for any location where the
10 President or Vice President regularly conducts offi-
11 cial business, which shall—

12 (A) include the name of each visitor, the
13 name of each individual with whom the visitor
14 met, and the purpose of the visit; and

15 (B) shall be updated every 30 days.

16 (2) The annual salary of each White House em-
17 ployee, which shall be updated quarterly, and the fol-
18 lowing:

1 (A) The number of employees who are paid
2 at a rate of basic pay equal to or greater than
3 the rate of basic pay then currently paid for
4 level V of the Executive Schedule of section
5 5316 of title 5 and who are employed in the
6 White House Office, the Executive Residence at
7 the White House, the Office of the Vice Presi-
8 dent, the Domestic Policy Staff, or the Office of
9 Administration, and the aggregate amount paid
10 to such employees.

11 (B) The number of employees employed in
12 such offices who are paid at a rate of basic pay
13 which is equal to or greater than the minimum
14 rate of basic pay then currently paid for GS-
15 16 of the General Schedule of section 5332 of
16 title 5, United States Code, but which is less
17 than the rate then currently paid for level V of
18 the Executive Schedule of section 5316 of such
19 title and the aggregate amount paid to such
20 employees.

21 (C) The number of employees employed in
22 such offices who are paid at a rate of basic pay
23 which is less than the minimum rate then cur-
24 rently paid for GS-16 of the General Schedule
25 of section 5332 of title 5, United States Code,

1 and the aggregate amount paid to such employ-
2 ees.

3 (D) The number of individuals detailed
4 under section 112 of title 3, United States
5 Code, for more than 30 days to each such of-
6 fice, the number of days in excess of 30 each
7 individual was detailed, and the aggregate
8 amount of reimbursement made as provided by
9 the provisions of section 112 of such title.

10 (E) The number of individuals whose serv-
11 ices as experts or consultants are procured
12 under chapter 2 title 3, United States Code, for
13 service in any such office, the total number of
14 days employed, and the aggregate amount paid
15 to procure such services.

16 (3) The most recent financial disclosure state-
17 ment for each White House employee filed pursuant
18 to the Ethics in Government Act of 1978 (5 U.S.C.
19 App.), which shall be updated annually.

20 (b) EXCEPTIONS.—Except as provided in subsection
21 (c)(3), the requirement described in subsection (a) does
22 not apply to any visitor record that relates to—

23 (1) the social security number, taxpayer identi-
24 fication number, birth date, home address, or per-
25 sonal phone number of an individual, the name of an

1 individual who is less than 18 years old, or a finan-
2 cial account number;

3 (2) a law enforcement concern;

4 (3) a national security threat;

5 (4) the personal safety of an employee of the
6 Executive Office of the President; or

7 (5) personal visits that do not involve any offi-
8 cial or political business.

9 (c) RECORDS WITHHELD.—With respect to a visitor
10 record excepted under subsection (b), the Executive Office
11 of the President shall—

12 (1) disclose the number of records withheld
13 every 30 days;

14 (2) post any such excepted record on the
15 website described under subsection (a) if the Execu-
16 tive Office of the President determines that the
17 record is no longer subject to an exception described
18 in subsection (b); and

19 (3) notwithstanding subsection (b), post any
20 reasonably segregable portion that is not covered by
21 an exception described in subsection (b) of any such
22 excepted record on the website described under sub-
23 section (a).
