1 SEC. 1048. PROHIBITION ON AERIAL SURVEILLANCE.

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Except as otherwise provided in 3 subsection (b), an unmanned aircraft system (as such 4 term is defined in section 331 of the FAA Modernization 5 and Reform Act of 2012) operated by Department of Defense may not be used for the targeted surveillance of any 6 7 United States citizen in the United States, and information obtained thereby may not be entered into evidence 8 9 before any court or in any agency proceeding.

10 (b) EXCEPTIONS.—Subsection (a) does not apply—
11 (1) if a warrant issued by a court of competent
12 jurisdiction;

(2) if there exist exigent circumstances warranting the use of such an unmanned aircraft system in a way described in such subsection; or

(3) to the extent that such subsection would
 conflict with section 130i of title 10, United States
 Code.
