

AMENDMENT TO H. RES. 676, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. POLIS OF COLORADO

Add at the end the following new section:

1 SEC. 4. (a) Immediately upon adoption of this resolu-
2 tion the Speaker shall, pursuant to clause 2(b) of rule
3 XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee of
4 the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 15) to provide for comprehensive
6 immigration reform and for other purposes. All points of
7 order against consideration of the bill are waived. General
8 debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed
9 one hour equally divided and controlled by the chair and
10 ranking minority member of the Committee on the Judici-
11 ary. After general debate the bill shall be considered for
12 amendment under the five-minute rule. All points of order
13 against provisions in the bill are waived. At the conclusion
14 of consideration of the bill for amendment the Committee
15 shall rise and report the bill to the House with such
16 amendments as may have been adopted. The previous
17 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and
18 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening
19 motion except one motion to recommit with or without in-
20 structions. If the Committee of the Whole rises and re-

1 ports that it has come to no resolution on the bill, then
2 on the next legislative day the House shall, immediately
3 after the third daily order of business under clause 1 of
4 rule XIV, resolve into the Committee of the Whole for fur-
5 ther consideration of the bill.

6 (b) Clause 1(c) of rule XIX shall not apply to the
7 consideration of H.R. 15.
