AMENDMENT TO H.R. 4 OFFERED BY Mr. Polis of Colorado

At the end of title V, add the following:

1	SEC CREDIT FOR INSTALLING CRASH-RESISTANT
2	FUEL SYSTEMS IN ROTORCRAFT.
3	(a) In General.—Subpart B of part IV of sub-
4	chapter A of chapter 1 of the Internal Revenue Code of
5	1986 is amended by inserting after section 30D the fol-
6	lowing new section:
7	"SEC. 30E. INSTALLATION OF CRASH-RESISTANT FUEL SYS-
8	TEMS IN ROTORCRAFT.
9	"(a) In General.—There shall be allowed as a cred-
10	it against the tax imposed by this chapter for the taxable
11	year an amount equal to 10 percent of the qualified fuel
12	system installation costs which are paid or incurred by the
13	taxpayer during the taxable year.
14	"(b) Definitions.—For purposes of this section—
15	"(1) QUALIFIED FUEL SYSTEM INSTALLATION
16	COSTS.—The term 'qualified fuel system installation
17	costs' means costs paid or incurred to install a
18	crash-resistant fuel system in an emergency medical
19	rotorcraft that did not, before such installation, have
20	a crash-resistant fuel system.

1	"(2) Crash-resistant fuel system.—The
2	term 'crash-resistant fuel system' means a crash re-
3	sistant fuel system in compliance with the require-
4	ments under paragraphs (1), (2), (3), (5), and (6)
5	of section 27.952(a) and section 27.952(f) or para-
6	graphs (1) , (2) , (3) , (5) , and (6) of section
7	29.952(a) and section 29.952(f) of title 14, Code of
8	Federal Regulations.
9	"(3) Emergency medical rotorcraft.—The
10	term 'emergency medical rotorcraft' means, with re-
11	spect to a taxable year, a rotorcraft that is used in
12	the provision of emergency medical services during
13	such year.".
14	(b) Clerical Amendment.—The table of sections
15	for such subpart A is amended by inserting after the item
16	relating to section 30D the following new item:
	"Sec. 30E. Installation of crash-resistant fuel systems in rotorcraft."
17	(c) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
18	this section shall apply to taxable years beginning after
19	December 31, 2018.
