## SEC. 12. CONDUCT OF RESEARCH INTO EFFECTS OF CAN NABIS ON HEALTH OUTCOMES OF CERTAIN VETERANS.

4 (a) RESEARCH.—In carrying out the responsibilities 5 of the Secretary of Veterans Affairs under section 7303 of title 38, United States Code, the Secretary may conduct 6 7 and support research relating to the efficacy and safety of medical cannabis on the health outcomes of covered vet-8 erans diagnosed with chronic pain, post-traumatic stress 9 10 disorder, and other conditions the Secretary determines 11 appropriate. The Secretary shall ensure that such research is conducted in accordance with applicable regulations re-12 lating to the oversight of research, including such regula-13 14 tions prescribed by the Office of Research and Development of the Department of Veterans Affairs, the Depart-15 16 ment of Health and Human Services (including through the National Institute on Drug Abuse), the Food and 17 Drug Administration, the Drug Enforcement Administra-18 tion, and the National Institutes of Health. 19

(b) DATA PRESERVATION.—Research conducted pur suant to subsection (a) shall include a mechanism to en sure the preservation of all data, including all data sets,
 collected or used for purposes of the research required by
 subsection (a) in a manner that will facilitate further re search.

7 (c) REPORTS.—During the five-year period beginning
8 on the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary
9 shall submit periodically, but not less frequently than an10 nually, to the Committees on Veterans' Affairs of the
11 House of Representatives and the Senate reports on—

12 (1) the implementation of this section; or

(2) the rationale of the Secretary with respectto determining not to implement this section.

(d) COVERED VETERAN DEFINED.—In this section,
the term "covered veteran" means a veteran who is enrolled in the patient enrollment system of the Department
of Veterans Affairs under section 1705 of title 38, United
States Code.
